Participation in the NL Pavilion at Gulfood Manufacturing 2023

The costs for participation in one of the NL Pavilions are $\in 875,00$ (excl. VAT) per m2 of exhibition space. Per participating company there is a mandatory insurance of $\in 156,00$ (excl. VAT). An amount of $\in 370,00$ (excl. VAT) for internet listing and $\in 285,00$ (excl. VAT) for registration fees to be paid. These costs are imposed by the exhibition organizers and include 5% VAT. Minimum stand size is 12 m2 (blocks are 4 m deep) and maximum standspace is 24 m2. This in order to also give new companies the opportunity to participate.

The conditions of participation can be found, together with the registration form, in the annex. In order to participate in the exhibition, you must have the registration form fully completed by a person within your organization who acts with power of attorney and is registered with the Chamber of Commerce as authorized to sign. If this is not met, the registration is not valid.

Deadline for application is **Friday 22 April**. Be quick because the space is really limited and there is a lot of interest of Dutch companies to participate! Given the limited space, applications will be honored in order of entry and availability of space.

The stand space allocated to you by OEM may also differ from the m2 you have requested.
